

Each year, Placer County ACSA Charter awards scholarships during the month of May to support educational endeavors of our youth. There are four separate categories, each requiring its own specific application submission. Application requirements are listed below.

- **Category A** For current high school seniors planning to attend college/training with a preference given for those planning a career of education. There are two (2) available in this category.
- **Category B** For a current high school senior **enrolled in a continuation or alternative high school** planning to attend college/training. There are two (2) available in this category.
- **Category C** For current high school seniors planning to attend college/training who are children/grandchildren of current Placer County Charter ACSA members. There are two (2) available in this category.
- **Category D** For a **currently enrolled** college student studying for a career in education. There are four (4) available in this category.

## **<u>Eligibility</u>**

- 1. For Categories A, B and C the student must be a graduating high school senior in the year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- 2. For Category D the student must be enrolled in college.

## **Criteria for Selection**

- 1. Enrollment and completion of required courses.
- 2. In school and outside of school participation in leadership and activities.

**<u>Application</u>** Each completed application must include the following items:

- □ An application form filled out by the applicant
- □ A copy of the applicant's transcripts
- □ Two letters of recommendation, at least one must be from a staff member.

### A completed application must be received by May 1st.
