

3) : Write 1-2 pages entitled “What I Imagined, Assumed, or Knew”

College:

- Write what you imagined, assumed or knew about colleges or careers before you begin your search. You might start with the fantasies you held; you might imagine yourself as a college student. Perhaps you had some assumptions about a particular school, program or major you wanted to explore. You already had some facts about the subject of college, based on your own experiences and observations.

Career:

- Or, if you are planning to enter the military or a career immediately after high school, imagine yourself in boot camp or in the barracks writing a letter home telling the folks about your life in the Army or Navy. Likewise, you can imagine yourself in your first new job. Write a journal type entry about your life in one of these careers.

It is O.K. to be creative and to experiment by describing what you consider to be your ideal workplace, college setting, curriculum, social life, etc. This section is designed to tap your imagination. Don't limit it!
